



## HALFWAY HOME DOG RESCUE

Please remember that a rescue dog will rarely settle in within a few hours/days of bringing it home, no dog will. Many of these dogs have been through so much they need time and patience to settle. This is especially true where introducing a dog to a home with a resident cat.

### **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

The normal adoption fee is £150, but at times this may vary.

The dog will have it's first vaccination, be microchipped and if needed it will be wormed and flea treated. The dog will have any medical treatment that we deem necessary.

It is a condition of adoption that, unless already done, all dogs must be neutered. You will get a voucher to use at our vets towards this cost - it will cost you £30 for a male or £50 for a female – the vets will invoice the balance to the Rescue.

You will be responsible for getting the 2<sup>nd</sup> vaccination done at your vets.

There is no need to make an appointment to come to view dogs – we are open Wednesday through to Sunday between 11am – 3pm.

Viewing at any other time is by appointment only.

If you have another dog please bring it along with you so they can meet any dog you may consider adopting. Also it is best for any children in the house to come along too.

We do not know much history for most of our dogs so often we do not know if they have lived with either children or cats. If you have a cat please remember that it can take a while (this can be a minimum of 2 – 3 weeks) for the dog and cat to settle down to live together.

We will ask you to complete a pre-adoption form which will help us to try to match the right dog to your home.
